Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This past year (2023) started out quite normal as most years do for Tom and myself. Life seemed good and comfortable and then March hit our house coming in like a lamb and out like a *LION!* It was at the end of March that my husband of 53 years was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. Many of you know him as Tom Heins, Past Grand Master. Cancer is not new to our families, we lost both of our mothers to cancer when they were much younger than us, but we have also witnessed others that have fought and survived it. What a "whammy" when you get the news. It takes your breath away; brings back way too many memories and makes you feel like there is no hope. Especially pancreatic cancer.

Museum Meanderings


When we left off in Dec., you were informed that the first pilgrimage to the museum took place in May of 1954. The pilgrimages were reported as gala event each year according to the information posted in the local newspapers and the *Wisconsin Odd Fellow*. The very first pilgrimage took place in 1954, but May 24th, 1955 Pilgrimage was the day of the institution of the Odd Fellow Shrine Lodge #100 and the Rebekah Shrine Lodge #000. In those days members of our orders joined either the Odd Fellow Shrine #100 or Rebekah Shrine #000 at 50¢ per year. The institution of these two lodges was an all-day affair with a parade from the top of High Street all the way to Soldiers Memorial Park. A speech was given by Dr. Clifford Lord, Director of the Wisconsin Historical Society. He spoke on the historical significance of the Odd Fellow Shrine. There were meals offered and entertainment for about 500 members. It was written in the June, 1955 *Wisconsin Odd Fellow*, "In closing of the day, this event goes to show that these two lodges (#100 & #000) prove how powerful a force Odd Fellowship can really be when it makes up its mind to move forward and apply itself. Yes, once again this Spring, Odd Fellowship showed it is "*on the March*." Wow, what a festive day it must have been.

Each May since 1954, there has been a Saturday set aside for the Pilgrimage to the Odd Fellow Shrine. Lodge #100 and Lodge #000 continued to be in existence until May of 1992 when the Museum Board changed the by-laws and made every Odd Fellow and Rebekah member in the state of Wisconsin a member of the museum's organization. We all pay dues to the museum through our per capita assessment each year. The museum board members are now voted on at our Grand Lodge session in June of each year. Our museum is a wonderful part of our Odd Fellow history and each and every one of us should be proud that our fore fathers chose to preserve this building and all of its contents.

This May will be the 70th pilgrimage. Mark your calendar for May 18th. More information about the pilgrimage will be in future *Wisconsin Odd Fellow* magazines.

It is a huge undertaking to keep it up and running. Many thanks go out to all who have made donation over the years. Our latest improvement was the sliding glass doors on the display cabinets. What a wonderful improvement. Keep those donations flowing.

MISTY'S Recipe Exchange



Ground Beef Gnocchi

This quick one pan ground beef gnocchi recipe has a creamy tomato sauce and turns store-bought gnocchi into a gourmet meal. It'll be a family favorite!

Prep Time	Cook Time	Total Time
5 mins	20 mins	25 mins



Course: Main Course Cuisine: Italian American

Keyword: beef and gnocchi, gnocchi bolognese, ground beef gnocchi, hamburger gnocchi Servings: 4 Author: Natasha Bull

Ingredients

1 pound extra lean ground beef

1/2 medium onion chopped

3 cloves garlic minced

1 dash Italian seasoning

1 (14 fluid ounce) can diced tomatoes with juices

1/3 cup chicken or beef broth

3/4 cup heavy/whipping cream

1 pound uncooked potato gnocchi

1/2 cup freshly grated parmesan cheese

Salt & pepper to taste

Instructions

- 1. Brown the ground beef and onion in a skillet over medium-high heat for 7-10 minutes. If there's lots of excess fat, spoon most of it out.
- 2. Stir in the garlic and Italian seasoning.
- 3. Add the diced tomatoes, chicken broth, cream, and gnocchi to the pan, and give it a good stir. Once the sauce starts to bubble again, cover the pan and reduce the heat to medium. Cook for 5 minutes.
- 4. Uncover the pan, stir it, and let it cook for another few minutes, or until the gnocchi has cooked through and is nice and soft and the sauce has thickened to your liking.
- 5. Stir in the parmesan cheese and salt & pepper as needed. Serve immediately.


