



#### **GRAND CHAPLAIN'S LETTER**

Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.







Dear members of all Wisconsin Odd Fellow and Rebekah Lodges,

Your Odd Fellow and Rebekah Museum Board will be holding its annual May meeting on May 20<sup>th.</sup> All members of our Order are invited to attend this meeting. It is your museum and the board looks forward to your assistance in making wise decision for the museum.

How did the museum come about? The building at 112 Front St. was built in 1838 by Iowa Lodge #1. Iowa Lodge #1 was the first lodge to be instituted in Wisconsin in 1835. The first members were lead miners who settle in Mineral Point. They had belonged to an Odd Fellow lodge in Pottsville, PA and wished to continue in Odd Fellowship. Thomas Wildey, founder of Odd Fellows in the USA, laid the corner stone for the building that is our museum. The lodge was quite active but membership fell and they relinquished their charter and let the building go back to the lien holders. Later in the 1800's, Iowa Lodge #1 reinstated. The members purchased the top part of the building at 114 High St. and met there until 2003.


In 1926, the members of Iowa Lodge #1 asked the Grand Lodge of Wisconsin to consider the purchase of the original lodge hall at 112 Front St. The purpose for the purchase was for it to become a place for IOOF artifacts to be displayed. They wanted to preserve the history of Odd Fellowship. They also wanted a day be set aside each May for all members to make a "Pilgrimage" to the newly purchased building.

Hundreds of members from all over the state attended the pilgrimage to the "Shrine" in Mineral Point. It was a day of visiting the building, eating a pasty or chicken pie meal, attending the annual meeting and fellowship with other members. A day enjoyed by all. Sadly, over the years the attendance has dwindled and very few members attend the yearly Museum Day.

So, I am asking all members to consider attending our annual meeting in May. There is more information to be found in this issue of *Wisconsin Odd Fellow*. The museum board needs your help in maintaining and improving our Odd Fellow & Rebekah Museum. It belongs to all members of the Order. Come visit Mineral Point where Odd Fellowship began and help preserve the history of the Odd Fellows and Rebekahs. Hoping to see many of you.

- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese divided

#### Instructions

- 2. Brown your ground beef with garlic and drain
- 3. In a large bowl, mix all ingredients together, except for 1 cup of shredded cheese and pour into lightly greased  $9 \times 13$  baking dish
- 4. Top all the ingredients with your remaining cheese
- 5. Place dish in oven and cook for 20-25 minutes until cheese is bubbly and tots are cooked through


